SUNDAY 2nd AUGUST – TRINITY 8- The Sunday service is being recorded "live" in St Hilary's and will be available on Youtube & Facebook from Sunday morning onward. Search for St Hilary's Wallasey and subscribe to the page. Details to be sent via email. If we don't have your email address, contact us to have the link sent to you. 11.45am to 12.45pm - Informal "refreshments" time on Zoom after the service from 11.45am until 12.45pm. (an email containing a weblink will be circulated on Saturday to all for whom we have an address).

RE-OPENING ST HILARY'S - The PCC has decided to wait until September before we re-open the church building for private prayer and for public worship. This is for 3 main reasons: 1. to be sure we have everything in place; 2. to allow time to experiment with "broadcasting" the live services from church (called "live-streaming"); 3. to ascertain from you your intentions about attending church, given the restrictions that will surround our meetings for some time to come (eg distancing, hand-washing, face coverings, no singing). As always we keep you as fully informed as possible.

<u>SERVICES DURING AUGUST</u> - It has not yet proved possible for us to properly "livestream" services direct from church. We

need some more equipment and a lot more know- how! For Sunday 2nd August, we are recording the service in church with no editing or second takes, and then making it available on Youtube and Facebook. We aim to be able to "live-stream" from 6th September, when we also expect to begin welcoming people back to the church building. So there should be a congregation in church and people worshipping in their homes simultaneously!
